Entry/Exit Criteria



- Program Entry Invitation
 - o 2+ Grade Levels Below in Reading Comprehension
 - o Based on Spring 2020 Comprehension scores
- Program Exit
 - At or Above Grade Level Reading Comprehension
 - Benchmark in February
 - Benchmark in June

Students who show on or above grade level proficiency will be offered to take part in

MHRD Reads - an independent reading option.

School Elements



Family/guardian of students identified for reading support will be notified in writing via email



Upon approval, students will receive additional support in the area of reading for 60 minutes each week



Reading Plus Benchmarks in February and June will be utilized to determine individual reading growth levels 66
