State Testing Requirements for Graduation

Class of 2024 only

Students in the Class of 2024 must have one qualifying score in each area (ELA and Math):

English Language Arts (choose one)	Mathematics (choose one)
725 or higher on the NJGPA ELA	725 or higher on the NJGPA Math
The following options are only available if students have taken the NJGPA and earned a valid score:	
450 or higher on SAT EBWR Section	440 or higher on SAT Math Section
23 or higher on SAT Reading	22 or higher on the SAT Math Test
420 or higher on PSAT10 or PSAT/NMSQT EBRW	420 or higher on PSAT10 or PSAT/NMSQT Math
21 or higher on PSAT10 or PSAT/NMSQT Reading	21 or higher on PSAT10 or PSAT/NMSQT Math
17 or higher on ACT Reading	17 or higher on ACT Math
5 or higher on Accuplacer WritePlacer 4 or higher on Accuplacer WritePlacer ESL	49 or higher on Accuplacer Elementary Algebra 250 or higher on Accuplacer Quantitative Reasoning, Algebra, & Statistics (QAS)
Pass the NJDOE Portfolio Process: ELA*	Pass the NJDOE Portfolio Process: Mathematics*
Students with significant disabilities may be exempt from passing the state testing requirement for graduation as per the IEP Team. Students exempted from taking the NJGPA as per the IEP Team are required to take the DLM (Dynamic Learning Maps) alternative assessment.
