Dear Morris Hills Regional District Community,

We hope this letter finds you healthy and safe. As you know, due to the current increase of COVID-19 cases throughout the tri-state area, the State of New Jersey has now moved to Very High Risk Transmission (Red). We are anticipating a rise in the number of students required to quarantine due to both the increased rate of transmission and travel during the holiday break.

As a result of the anticipated increase of students required to quarantine, beginning Wednesday, January 5, 2022, the Morris Hills Regional District will provide remote audio access to classroom instruction for any student required to quarantine by the district and only for the duration of his or her required exclusion from school. This instruction will be synchronous and follow the student's regular school day schedule. Quarantined students will have audio access to their core classes, including English, Social Studies, Math, Science, World Language, and Health via a Zoom link provided by their teachers. The link will only be available for students required to quarantine and can be accessed in Google Classroom.

While not as effective as in-person instruction, we believe this allows quarantined students continued access to instruction during their quarantine period and affords continuity of instruction.
