



The Mission of AVID






AVID's mission is to close the achievement gap by preparing all students for college readiness and success in a global society.

AVID: 40+ Years of Success



Over 40 years, AVID has become one of the most successful college-preparatory programs and today reaches more than 400,000 students in approximately 4,800 schools in 48 states and 16 other countries.





What is AVID?



- A structured, college preparatory system working directly with schools and districts
- A direct support structure for students determined to succeed in higher-level courses
- A schoolwide approach to curriculum and rigor adopted by more than 4,800 schools in 48 states and 16 countries
- A professional development program providing training for teachers throughout the world







AVID IS NOT:

A remedial program

A program for students already taking multiple honors and AP courses

A study skills program

A replacement for supports provided by IEPs or 504 Plans

AVID IS:

A program for motivated students who think they can take more challenging coursework if they have great teachers and support during the day

- In September 2023, the MHRD proudly welcomed 20 students into the AVID Class of 2027
- □ Currently we have 86 AVID students in grades 9-12
- 39 AVID-trained teachers at MH (2 in each core subject area)
- The MHRD offers continued support to its AVID Content Area and Elective teachers and PD opportunities to all subject area teachers

- Motivation is key!








Why AVID Works

How to Join the Program



Application Process:

- Fill out the online application and sign up for an interview by February 12th.
- Attend your interview on February 13th or 15th. Submit your required essay (either at the time of application or via email no later than your interview date)
- AVID is at Morris Hills HS.
 - Students living in the Knolls sending area will become Morris
 Hills students for all academics, athletics, and activities for
 grades 9-12. Transportation will be provided.
- If you are accepted and decide to join AVID, you agree to stay in the program for one year. (Knolls students who withdraw can either stay at Hills or return to Knolls.)

APPLICATIONS MUST BE RECEIVED BY February 12th.
