SUMMER WRITING CAMP

THE COLLEGE APPLICATION ESSAY



Description: College-bound students will leave this three-day **in-person workshop** with a complete draft of their college application essay. Participants will receive instruction in topic development, essay structure and organization, using anecdotal evidence, and the revision process. Extensive one-on-one conferencing and document review by experienced writing instructors will be beneficial not only for the college application essay, but also for future academic writing situations. Instructors will utilize Google Apps for Education to conduct live instruction and editing while providing guidance throughout the process.
