Code of Conduct

The following rules will be strictly enforced. Students who violate any of these rules will be removed from the program, and no refund will be given:

- No drugs or alcohol are permitted in the building, on school grounds, or during virtual instruction.
- Smoking/Vaping is not permitted in the building, on school grounds, or during virtual instruction.
- Fighting, bullying, or harassment, whether in person or online, will result in immediate removal from the program.
- Cell phones, iPods, and other electronic devices must be turned off before entering the building. Students may not use electronic devices in the classroom without the permission of the teacher. Any student found to be using an unauthorized electronic device will have it confiscated, and a parent/guardian must come to the school to retrieve it.
- Plagiarism, cheating, copying homework, or other forms of academic dishonesty will not be tolerated in either an in-person or virtual environment. Students found with an unauthorized electronic device during an assessment will receive a zero on the assessment.
- Offensive or disruptive items are not permitted in either an in-person or virtual environment.
- Students must abide by the Summer Program Attendance Policy. Students who miss a class will be responsible for all missed work, including assessments. Teachers will not be available to re-teach a missed lesson.
- Students must abide by the District's Acceptable Use Policy for all computers and electronic devices.
- Students must abide by the dress code. All students should be dressed appropriately for an academic environment. All skirts or shorts must be no shorter than 5 inches above the knee. Tight or revealing clothing is not permissible. Hats, bandanas, and hoods are not allowed. The dress code also applies when students are learning in a virtual environment.
- Students will be held responsible for reimbursement for any damaged equipment or text that is not returned. All transcripts will be held by the school until reimbursement is received.
- In-person students will be required to self-screen for symptoms of COVID-19 on a daily basis using the district screener. Students who are ill or have symptoms should not attend in-person and will be given an option to participate virtually, if appropriate.
- Students participating virtually are required to have their cameras on at all times with their faces showing.
- Recording of virtual sessions is prohibited.
- Students are not permitted to log into a virtual session while driving a vehicle.
- Infractions not covered above will be handled at the discretion of the Administration in accordance with district board policies.

Attendance Policy

- For the Summer Acceleration Program, daily attendance and punctuality are critical to student success in the course. No more than **2 absences** will be permitted for Algebra I and Geometry H; for Personal Finance and SAT Prep, only **1 absence is permitted**. If a student exceeds the number of absences, he or she will automatically be withdrawn from the course, and no refund will be given, unless a student has a documented illness. All courses begin promptly at 8 AM and end at 1 PM. Students who arrive late (after 8 AM) or leave early (before 1 PM) on a regular basis will be removed from the course with no refund given.
- If a student is ill or has symptoms of COVID-19, please contact the teacher as soon as possible, and we will provide you with additional instructions.
