- Transportation is the responsibility of the parent/guardian.
- Tuition fees are non-refundable unless a course is canceled due to low enrollment.
- This program is for enrichment purposes only and is non-credit bearing.
- Students are permitted to bring a nut-free snack.

**Code of Conduct**
