VIRTUAL SUMMER WRITING CAMP
THE COLLEGE APPLICATION ESSAY



Description: College-bound students will leave this three-day **virtual workshop** with a complete draft of their college application essay. Participants will receive both live and pre-recorded instruction in topic development, essay structure and organization, using anecdotal evidence, and the revision process. Extensive one-on-one conferencing and document review by experienced writing instructors via Zoom/Meet will be beneficial not only for the college application essay, but for future academic writing situations as well. Instructors will utilize Google Apps for Education to conduct live instruction and editing while providing guidance throughout the process.

- ❑ Students must have access to a laptop or school issued chromebook.

Code of Conduct
