State Testing Requirements for Graduation  
Class of 2025 only

Students in the Class of 2025 must have one qualifying score in each area (ELA and Math):

| Students with significant disabilities may be exempt from <i>passing</i> the state testing requirement for graduation after repeated attempts as per the IEP Team. Students exempted from <i>taking</i> the NJGPA as per the IEP Team are required to take the DLM (Dynamic Learning Maps) alternative assessment. |   |
