EXCELLENT

(20-19)

The *entire text* is *full* of annotations. A great variety of textual passages are marked: words, meaningful quotations, phrases, long passages. Marginal comments accomplish a great variety of purposes: analysis of literary devices & their affect on the reader (irony, imagery, etc.), summarizing, posing questions, reacting to ideas, analysis of character, plot, themes and symbols

GOOD

(18-17)

The text contains *many* annotations throughout *most* of the text. A variety of textual passages are marked-- words, meaningful quotations, phrases, long passages. Marginal comments accomplish a variety of purposes—summarizing, posing questions, reacting to ideas, identification of some literary devices with some analysis of character, plot, themes and symbols

ADEQUATE BUT NEEDS
IMPROVEMENT

(16-14)

The text contains *some* annotations. *Some* chapters or sections of text unmarked or annotations stop after a certain page. Little variety is reflected in types of textual passages marked. Marginal comments accomplish only a few purposes and provide only limited response to the text—such as only plot summaries with limited or no reactions, nothing more than identification of literary devices (no analysis), no questioning techniques used.

LACKS ADVANCED
COURSE QUALITY--
REQUIRES CONFERENCE

(13-12)

The text is only *sparsely* annotated *if at all* and is not of advanced course quality. No variety is reflected in types of textual passages are marked. Marginal comments are limited in meaning and show a lack of thoughtful response to the text or analysis of the text.
