The Morris Hills Regional School District is busy preparing for the school year, and we would like to inform you of an exciting addition to our instructional program for the 2018-2019 school year. Strategic technology integration is key to supplementing an authentic, engaging, and relevant learning environment. Our goal is to cultivate a dynamic environment that will enhance teaching and learning. Toward that end, MHRD has implemented a 1:1 Chromebook initiative at both Morris Knolls High School and Morris Hills High School. Every 9th grade student will receive a Chromebook that will be used to foster creativity, critical thinking, and collaboration. Students will be provided daily access to valuable applications and resources to strengthen student achievement across the curriculum and foster the development of 21st century skills.

To prepare for implementation, our teachers have been participating in a 1:1 pilot program which has afforded them the opportunity to attend professional development workshops, as well as incorporate the technology into their daily instruction. Furthermore, the district has made great strides in preparing our classrooms with infrastructure needs, including wireless capabilities and updated software that provides a foundation for students and teachers to enhance their educational experience.

Chromebooks will be distributed to freshmen students on the following dates:

- **Morris Knolls High School** **September 24th & 25th**
- **Morris Hills High School** **September 26th & 27th**

In advance of Chromebook distribution, all students and parents must complete the following using MySchoolBucks. Please visit our website for more information.

- **Sign and agree to the Acceptable Use Policy**
- **Sign the Anti-Big Brother Act Annual Notification Form**
- **Pay the \$27.50 maintenance/insurance fee**

The annual \$27.50 maintenance/insurance fee must be paid by Friday, September 7, 2018. This fee covers unintentional and non-negligent damage in addition to a yearly accidental damage waiver. Students who qualify for free/reduced lunch may also be eligible for low-cost home internet options-- additional details will be provided in early September.
