MORRIS HILLS PARKING REGULATIONS

Please read each of these regulations carefully as they will be strictly enforced! Driving to school is a privilege. Failure to comply with these rules will result in disciplinary actions which may include: police summons, school fines, towing, loss of parking privilege, and school disciplinary consequences.

1. Parking on campus is a senior only privilege.
2. Students and their parent/guardian must provide consent for the student to be entered in the District's Random Substance Testing Program prior to receiving a parking permit.
3. Every vehicle parked on the grounds of Morris Hills High School must display a permanently affixed window decal on the driver's side of the rear window.
4. Parking decals may be purchased by SENIORS ONLY in the general office at a price of \$20.00. **Students will receive a permanent parking decal only after they have attended a Safe Driving Class sponsored by our local police with a parent/guardian.** The decal must be placed on the rear window on the driver's side of the registered vehicle, and **that vehicle only may be driven by that student.**
5. Students must allow us to photocopy their driver's license and registration for insurance purposes. Students must also submit an Emergency Form for the current school year. Students must be driving to school on a regular basis to be eligible for a permit. If a student only drives his or her parent's car occasionally, the school will issue temporary a permit as needed.
6. All vehicles must park correctly between the lines in a legal parking space. Failure to comply will result in parking tickets (\$5.00 for first offense, \$10.00 for second offense, and \$20.00 for third offense and subsequent offenses) and possible towing for continued infractions. Towing is at the owner's expense.
7. Once a vehicle is parked, it is to remain parked all day. Only students in approved school programs such as work study will be permitted with a pass to leave before the end of the school day. Failure to comply will result in loss of the parking privilege.
8. Any student caught driving carelessly or in excess of the posted speed limit will forfeit his/her parking privilege as well as face disciplinary action. Our School Resource Officer will monitor the senior parking area and enforce all Rockaway Boro driving ordinances.
9. While on school grounds, student vehicles may be subject to random searches using trained dogs and law enforcement personnel in an effort to enforce the district's zero tolerance policy for alcohol and drugs. In addition, student vehicles are subject to search under Board of Education Policy #5770.
10. A decal does not guarantee a student a parking space. Parking is available on a first come basis.
