PSAT/NMSQT and Pre-ACT Tests on October 11

Morris Knolls High School will be administering the PSAT/NMSQT to all students in Grades 10-11 and the Pre-ACT 8/9 to all students in Grade 9 on October 11. Seniors will participate in a college/post-secondary planning work session.

We will have an **early dismissal** on this day with two separate bus runs: **11:25 AM dismissal for seniors and regular testers and 1:05 PM dismissal for extended time testers.** Out-of-district Choice and APA extended time testers WILL NOT have a second bus run available at 1:05 PM. Transportation will be the sole responsibility of their family.

All testers should bring two No. 2 pencils with soft erasers and a scientific or graphing calculator for use on the mathematics section of the PSAT or Pre-ACT 8/9. All testers are asked to please check the demographics page of Aspen for their assigned testing location.
