Steps to Applying for College

- **STEP 1:** Update your <u>Naviance</u> account by moving colleges from "Colleges I'm Thinking About" to "Colleges I am Applying To".
- STEP 2: Work on your activity resume, college essay, senior brag sheet, and supplemental essays (if applicable).
- **STEP 3:** Check in with your teachers regarding letters of recommendation. You *must* enter your teachers in your Naviance Account.
- **STEP 4:** Submit college application, required application fee, and essay (if required) directly to the college.
- STEP 5: Use Naviance to request transcripts (<u>College Transcript Requests on Naviance</u>).
- **STEP 6** Visit <u>CollegeBoard</u> and/or your <u>ACT</u> account to send your scores to the colleges of which you have applied. You must do this directly from the testing website. Counselors **do not** have access to these accounts or scores!

Types of Applications

- Regular Decision
- ☐ Rolling Admission first come, first serve
- ☐ Early Decision usually 11/1 or 11/15
 - Binding
 - ☐ Can only apply to one!
- ☐ Early Action usually 11/1 or 11/15 (Southern colleges have a 10/15 deadline)
 - Non-binding
 - Can apply to more than one

Senior Year Timeline

Completed by the End of Junior Year

- •Begin/continue searching for colleges through <u>Naviance</u> (Safety/Target/Reach).
- •Create an appropriate email for college use.
- •Register with the <u>NCAA</u> if you are planning on playing D-I or D-II sports.
- •Complete Senior Brag Sheet and Parent Brag Sheet on Naviance!
- •Start an activity resume for college and scholarship applications: <u>Sample & Tips</u>
- •Schedule college visits and/or attend open houses.
- •Ask two teachers for letters of recommendation. Share the request form with your teachers!

Currently in Progress...

- Work on outlines for essays (Common App essay prompts).
- Create a <u>Common Application</u> and/or <u>Coalition Application</u> account and familiarize yourself with it.
- Add schools to your Common App and Naviance accounts.
 Match accounts on Naviance!
- Register for Fall <u>SAT/ACT</u> tests.
- · Visit colleges during fall open houses!
- Make sure you are satisfying all admissions/application requirements.
- Get organized! Make checklists for each school you are applying to where you can keep track of all your application deadlines.

Fall of Senior Year

- Use Naviance to finalize your college list!
- Add teachers recommendations to Naviance.
- Watch all <u>application deadlines</u> (ED, EA, Rolling, Regular, etc.)
- Request your transcript through Naviance by <u>following</u> these steps. Requests need to be submitted <u>10 school days</u> <u>prior</u> to your application deadline.
- <u>If applicable</u>, submit Self-Reported Academic Record (SRAR) for colleges (ex. Rutgers, Penn State, etc.)
- ED/EA applicants Finalize plans and prepare materials for October submission.
- Submit all required SAT or ACT scores **directly** from testing agencies!
- Finalize and submit all essays/applications.
- Begin gathering documents for the financial aid process and create FSA IDs.

Begin search for scholarship opportunities!

Winter of Senior Year

- Continue filing applications, if needed.
- Avoid senior slump! Mid-year and final grades matter! <u>Mid-year grade will be sent to ALL colleges.</u>
- Submit all required Financial Aid forms. <u>FAFSA</u> opens in December!
- Research new <u>scholarship opportunities</u>. Create only <u>ONE Going Merry</u> account! No parent accounts!
- File <u>Scholarship Processing Form</u> for paper scholarships ONLY.

Spring of Senior Year

- Respond to college acceptances and submit required fees.
- Follow up on applications (if not heard back).
- May 1st is Decision Day! Notify ALL colleges and your counselor of your decision.
- Keep your counselor informed of all decisions! Stay in touch!

June 2024!

- Complete Senior Survey on Naviance.
- Say thank you to all that helped you along the way!



Common Data Set

The Common Data Set is published annually for every college/university and is comprised of standards and definitions of data including freshman admission, financial aid, graduation rate, transfer admission, student demographics, academic offerings, instructional faculty/class size, and degrees conferred.

Please review <u>every</u> college your student is applying to with this resource!

Self-Reported Academic Records (SRAR)

- More schools are requiring SRAR! (ex. Clemson, FSU, Montclair, Rutgers, NYU, Penn State, Texas A&M, Uconn, Pittsburgh, etc).
- Student can complete this directly on Common App or Coalition App (if the school you are applying to requires it).
 - Some schools will redirect you to do it on their own site (ex. Rutgers) or through the main SRAR website.
- Counselors gave students a copy of their transcript during group meetings on 9/8!



NCAA Eligibility Center



It is mandatory that prospective student athletes who plan to participate in intercollegiate athletics at a NCAA Division I or II institution register with the Eligibility Center

Follow these steps:

- 1. Have a credit card ready.
- 2. Go to NCAA. Create an account.
- 3. After completing all forms, an email with a NCAA ID will be sent to you. Request transcripts in your NCAA account.
- 4. Add the NCAA to list of "Colleges I am Applying To" on Naviance.
- 5. Visit Naviance to request a transcript to be sent to NCAA.
- 6. Send SAT/ACT scores to NCAA using code 9999 for the "NCAA Eligibility Center".

Test Optional



Test optional allows the student to decide if they want to submit their SAT or ACT scores or not.

Our recommendation: if a student is *at or above* the average SAT or ACT score for a college, send the scores. If they are *below* the average SAT or ACT score, **do not send them!**


80% of colleges are currently test optional (insiderhighered.com). **Use this to your advantage!**

Naviance

How is information submitted?

- Most schools receive all documents from MKHS via Naviance.
- Student sign FERPA "Release of Information".
 - Waiving Right Why not? Colleges want a candid look!
- **Recommendations** asking for 2 academic based letters is standard.
 - No need to ask for more!
 - Be mindful that some colleges only accept one letter of recommendation.




Common App: Dashboard



MORRIS KNOLLS SCHOLARSHIP PROCEDURES AND REMINDERS

- 1. Use the tabs on the left to navigate to a list of local, National Scholarships, NJ and Regional Scholarships, and the Scholarship Processing Form.
- 2. Paper-based applications must be submitted to the School Counseling Department at least 2 weeks before the deadline listed on this website and must be accompanied by a Scholarship Processing Google Form found under the Scholarship Processing Form tab.
- 3. All local scholarships will be available on December 1st of Senior year. A Google Classroom announcement and email notification will be made to publicize this date. Local Scholarships will be posted online using Going Merry once available.
- 4. The number of scholarships that come through the Morris Knolls High School Counseling Office are a small fraction of the number of scholarship opportunities that are available nationwide. We recommend checking out these top scholarship websites (and remember that you should never pay for the right to apply for scholarships) to search for scholarships:

FAFSA (www.fafsa.ed.gov)

- You must register for a <u>FSA ID Number</u>. This will be your secure access to your FAFSA online (Available in December).
- Once you have secured a FSA ID, fill out the Pre-Application Worksheet – using previous year taxes.
- Follow the directions as provided on the website. 3.

Be aware of deadlines Each individual college has its own filing deadline!

CSS Profile CollegeBoard's Financial Aid Service

- CSS PROFILE is used by colleges to determine eligibility for institutional funding.
- You will need to check with your college/university if they require the <u>CSS PROFILE</u>

OR

- You can also check <u>here</u> for a complete list of schools that participate.
- CSS PROFILE Online Application for 2024 -2025 will be available on October 1st. You should file this application if your school requires it for the fall of 2024 or the spring of 2025.
