Voter Registration Requirements

To register in NJ, you must be:

A U.S. citizen

At least 17 years old, though you may not vote until you are 18

A resident of the country for 30 days before the election

A person not serving a sentence of incarceration

The registration deadline to vote in the next election is 21 days prior to the election day. The registrant must complete a Voter Registration Application and/or Party Affiliation Form. Mail or deliver the Voter Registration Application and/or Party Affiliation Form to the [County Commissioner of Registration or Superintendent of Elections](#) for your county.
