Dear Morris Hills High School Community,

Morris Hills High School will administer the state-mandated New Jersey Student Learning Assessment (NJSLA) to all students in Grades 9 and 11 on the following dates:

Testing will take place from 8:00 AM to 10:00 AM each day. Non-testers will follow a delayed opening schedule on all four days of testing beginning at 10:00 AM. On Thursday, May 25th, all seniors should arrive at school by 9:00 AM for the Senior Picnic. Seniors should report to the tennis courts for sign-in purposes on May 25th. The Morris Hills Regional School District will provide TWO scheduled bus runs: (1) Regular bus run for all testers and (2) a second bus run for all non-testers approximately 2-hours later than normal pickup time. Please note that all Academy of Math, Science & Engineering students, as well as all out-of-district choice students, will only have their normal bus run on the days of testing. Non-testers who arrive at school at the normal time should report to the cafeteria for a study hall. Z-Block classes are canceled during testing days.

Parents and guardians can help their children achieve success by:

- Encouraging students to stay positive and do their best on these assessments.
- Making sure students get a good night's sleep before testing.
- Ensuring that students eat a healthy breakfast each morning.
- Ensuring that students arrive at school on time.
- Ensuring that students arrive with earbuds/headphones and an approved calculator if desired.
- Making sure that students bring their Chromebook fully charged each day of testing.
