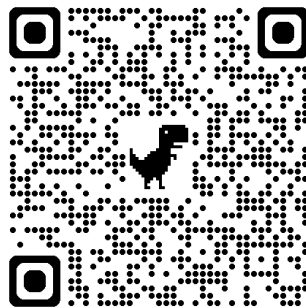

## 2024 – 2025 SENIOR PARKING APPLICATION INFORMATION

Seniors who wish to obtain a parking decal must fulfill the following requirements as well as complete the online application (click the link below or scan QR code). Once **all** requirements are met, ***students will be notified via their MHRD school email when they can pick up their decal*** in the General Office. Students must present their confirmation email upon pickup of their decal. Please allow one to four school days for the processing of applications.

- All obligations must be paid in full
- Parent/guardian must provide consent to the District's Random Substance Testing Program
- Students and their parent/guardian must have attended a Share the Keys presentation or viewed the [virtual presentation](#).
- Students must upload valid driver's license, vehicle registration, and car insurance documents to application. Any documents that are expired will not be accepted.
- Parking decal must be purchased through MySchoolBucks (\$25.00 non-refundable fee)

## MORRIS KNOLLS HIGH SCHOOL PARKING REGULATIONS

**Please read each of these regulations carefully as they will be strictly enforced! Driving to school is a privilege. Failure to comply with the regulations noted below will result in disciplinary action and the possible loss of your parking privilege.**

1. You must purchase a decal in order to park on campus. Parking decals are not transferable to any other vehicle. The cost of a parking decal is \$25.00 and must be purchased through MySchoolBucks. Cash or checks are not accepted.
2. Your decal is to be displayed at all times on the **left rear window (driver's side) of your car**. It must be properly affixed to the window. **DO NOT USE TAPE!** Failure to display your decal will result in a ticket and/or towing at your expense.
3. Use of a fake/expired decal will result in immediate towing and forfeiture of parking privilege.
4. You may only park in the Senior Parking Lot, on Knoll Drive above the Blue Line, or in the lot behind the baseball field ("Turf Lot").
5. Do not park in driveways, fire zones, stairway entrances, the faculty lots, numbered spots, or in the back of the school.
6. **If you can't find a parking space in one of the areas designated for seniors, DO NOT PARK IN A FACULTY SPACE.** Instead, park in front of the building, come into the General Office and discuss the situation with an administrator.
7. Parking in unauthorized areas will result in a ticket and forfeiture of privileges.
8. If you change vehicles you must remove the old decal and return it to the General Office before a new decal will be issued.
9. If you need to take a different vehicle to school in an emergency situation, stop in the General Office before school to get a temporary parking hang tag.
10. If you lose your decal, you probably will not receive another one, so **TAKE CARE OF IT AND LOCK YOUR CAR.**
11. **Under no circumstances are students to drive to Morris Hills or to Vo-Tech without specific permission** from the principal. Seniors who want to drive to Morris Hills or Vo-tech must complete the proper paperwork (including parent signature).
12. **The speed limit on campus is 10 m.p.h.** Speeding, careless driving, or other behavior considered by the school authorities to be dangerous to others or damaging to property will result in disciplinary consequences.
13. If you are issued a parking ticket(s) during the school year for a parking violation the cost is \$5.00 and \$10.00 for the second offense. The cost is \$20.00 for each subsequent offense & the vehicle will be towed.
14. **Leaving school grounds prior to regular dismissal**, unless excused by an administrator, will be treated as an unauthorized departure. This will likely result in loss of parking privilege and an in-school suspension.
15. **Students are not permitted in the parking area while school is in session.**
16. While on school grounds, **student vehicles are subject to random searches** using trained dogs and law enforcement personnel in an effort to enforce the district's zero tolerance policy for alcohol and drugs. In addition, student vehicles are subject to search under Board of Education Policy #5770.
