Graduating Seniors are excused from class on Monday, June 20 and should report to the auditorium between 8:30 - 8:45 A.M. for graduation rehearsal.


Any student who is absent from a quarterly exam will be required to make up the quarterly exam on the respective make-up days, Friday, June 17 and Monday, June 20<sup>th</sup>. Only emergency excusals will be considered. Planned absences for family vacations do not fall within the emergency excusal policy and will not be approved.

#### **FOURTH QUARTER EXAM EXEMPTION POLICY**

Seniors who earn an overall unweighted course average of 90 or higher (including quarter exams, with no one marking period grade below 85) can be exempt from the 4th quarter exam. To clarify, marking period grade below 85 does not include quarter exam grades. Seniors cannot be exempted from a project-based quarter exam. Students who choose the 4th quarter exemption should be aware that the average of their first two quarter exams will count toward 20% of their final grade average. Students may opt to take any 4th quarter exam even when exempt.
