On April 1<sup>st</sup> through April 3<sup>rd</sup>, Morris Knolls High School will be offering a free ACT Boot Camp for all Juniors. The boot camp will take place from 3:00 PM to 4:30 PM at Morris Knolls High School. The schedule will be as follows:

3:00 PM to 4:30 PM	Tuesday, April 1 <sup>st</sup>	Math, English or Science
3:00 PM to 4:30 PM	Wednesday, April 2 <sup>nd</sup>	Math, English or Science
3:00 PM to 4:30 PM	Thursday, April 3 <sup>rd</sup>	Math, English or Science

On April 1<sup>st</sup>, all ACT Boot Camp participants should report to B10 at 2:30 PM. At that time, students will be divided into their groups. Each group will be assigned a teacher and a subject. The session will begin at 3:00 PM. On April 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup>, the three groups will have a student teacher lesson from each of the other teachers.

The MHD Transportation Department will be running late buses for students to take home at the conclusion of the ACT Boot Camp. The late buses will line up in front of Morris Knolls High School. They will be a total of four late buses (Deville, Rockaway Brough, Rockaway Township and Waton). The buses will depart Morris Knolls High School at 4:45 PM.
