On February 8<sup>th</sup> through February 10<sup>th</sup>, Morris Knolls High School will be offering a free ACT Boot Camp **for all Juniors at Morris Knolls High School**. The boot camp will take place from 3:00 PM to 4:30 PM at Morris Knolls High School. The schedule will be as follows:

On February 8<sup>th</sup>, all ACT Boot Camp participants should report to B10 at 2:30PM. At that time, students will be divided into three groups. Each group will be assigned a teacher and subject. The session will begin at 3:00PM. On February 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> the three groups will receive instruction and lessons from each of the other teachers.

The MHRD Transportation Department will be running late buses for students to take home at the conclusion of the ACT Boot Camp. The late buses will line up in front of Morris Knolls High School. There will be a total of four late buses (Denville, Rockaway Borough, Rockaway Township, and Wharton). The buses will depart from Morris Knolls High School at **4:45 PM**.
