On March 5<sup>th</sup> & March 7<sup>th</sup>, Morris Knolls High School will be offering a free SAT Boot Camp for all **Juniors**. The boot camp will take place from 3:00 PM to 5:00 PM at Morris Knolls High School. It will be taught by our SAT experts at Morris Knolls High School. The schedule will be as follows:

The MHRD Transportation Department will be running late buses for students to take home at the conclusion of the SAT Boot Camp. The late buses will line up in front of Morris Knolls High School. There will be a total of four late buses (Denville, Rockaway Boro, Rockaway Township, and Wharton). The buses will depart from Morris Knolls High School at 5:15 PM.

On March 5<sup>th</sup>, all SAT Boot Camp participants should report to B10 at 2:30PM. At that time, students will be divided into two groups. Each group will be assigned a teacher and subject. The session will begin at 3:00PM. On March 7<sup>th</sup>, the two groups will switch teacher and subject, however, the start time will remain the same.

Students are asked to please bring the following items with them to the SAT Boot Camp – a pencil/pen, a notebook, and a calculator.

Please be advised that there will be an administration of the SAT Test through the College Board on Saturday, March 9<sup>th</sup>. The SAT Boot Camp is an excellent opportunity for our students to prepare one last time prior to the SAT administration. If your child is interested in taking the SAT Test on March 9<sup>th</sup> please visit the College Board website ([www.collegeboard.org](http://www.collegeboard.org)) for registration materials.
