On October 30th and 31st, Morris Knolls High School will be offering a free SAT Boot Camp for all Seniors. The boot camp will take place from 2:45 PM to 4:45 PM at Morris Knolls High School. It will be taught by our Math and English specialist at Morris Knolls High School. The schedule will be as follows:

The MHRD Transportation Department will be running late buses for students to take home at the conclusion of the SAT Boot Camp. The late buses will line up in front of Morris Knolls High School. There will be a total of four late buses (Denville, Rockaway Borough, Rockaway Township, and Wharton). The buses will depart from Morris Knolls High School at 5:00 PM.

On October 30th, all SAT Boot Camp participants should report to B10 at 2:30PM. At that time, students will be divided into two groups. Each group will be assigned a teacher and subject. The session will begin at 2:45PM. On October 31st, the two groups will switch teacher and subject, however, the start and end time will remain the same.

Students are asked to please bring the following items with them to the SAT Boot Camp – a pencil/pen, a notebook, and a calculator.

Please be advised that there will be an administration of the SAT Test through the College Board on Saturday, November 2nd. The SAT Boot Camp is an excellent opportunity for our students to prepare one last time prior to the SAT administration. If your child is interested in taking the SAT Test, please visit the College Board website (www.collegeboard.org) for registration materials.
